MGC Ballpark Modifications 10u baseball

- 1. Game time will be 1hr 15 minutes or 6 innings (finish the inning) unless a mercy rule is reached first which would be 12runs after 3 innings, 10 runs after 4 innings, or 8 runs after 5 innings.
- 2. Refer to the Usssa State rule book for all pitch count rules.
- 3. 9 players required in the field if you have them , teams with less than 9 present will be forced to take an out for each player they are short unless agreed upon otherwise by coaches at plate meeting. 7 is the minimum amount of player that can play less than 7 is an automatic forfeit
- 4. Once the pitcher is back on the mound with the ball and base runners have settled on a base. Base runners cannot leave bases to steal the next until the pitched ball crosses home plate or is batted into play. Players leaving early or not tagging up on a fly ball that is caught will be called out.
- 5. No Dropped 3rd strike.
- 6. Balks will be called but no penalty.
- 7. If a pitcher hits 3 batters in the same inning they will not be allowed to pitch the rest of the game but can play other positions.
- 8. The starting pitcher may re-enter the game at any time provided they are not over their pitch limit.
- 9. There will be a 7 run cap per inning.
- 10. While batting players must remain in the dugout unless they are occupying a base , at bat, or on deck.
- 11. If a batter bats out of order the first time will be a warning, the batter will be replaced by the correct batter and given the same ball and strike count. The second time will be an out.
- 12. 2 mound visits per pitcher upon the 2nd visit the pitcher should be replaced
- 13. ANY PLAYERS/COACHES/PARENTS/FANS SHOWING GROSS UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT WILL BE FORCED TO LEAVE THE PARK AND SUBJECT TO SUSPENSION.
- 14. Ejections: it is USSSA rule that if a player ,parent or fan of a team gets ejected the head coach must also be ejected along with player , parent or fans ,child or parent. MGCBP reserves the right to implement suspensions and stipulations to persons ejected from games, and the umpire will also have a say in when you get to return.
